CONFIRMATORY ASSIGNMENT

By Assignment dated April 14, 1999, Jennifer B. Cartledge (an inventor) did assign her entire one-half interest in and to the improvement in METHOD AND APPARATUS FOR CRYOGENIC SPRAY ABLATION OF GASTROINTESTINAL MUCOSA, identified as U.S. Serial No. 09/050,150 filed March 30, 1998 now identified as U.S. Patent No. 6,027,499. This Assignment included this patent, all original and reissued patents granted therefore and all divisions and continuations thereof to Frank Majerowicz.
