CONFIRMATORY ASSIGNMENT

DAVIDSON, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 48 Southern Boulevard, Chatham, New Jersey 07928, (referred to hereinafter as "Assignor"), has collaborated with his co-inventors, ERIC C. FLEISCHER, BERNHARD SCHAUB, MELVYN L. HENKIN and JORDAN M. LABY, to make a new and original SWIMMING POOL CLEANING APPARATUS AND PARTS THEREFOR, for which U.S. Provisional Application Serial No. 60/335,288 was previously filed on November 30, 2001 and for which a non-provisional application for United States Letters Patent was filed on October 25, 2002 as Application Serial No. 10/282,223.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby memorializes that he has sold, assigned and set over to said Assignee his entire right, title and interest in and for the United States of America and all other countries in and to said invention and the aforesaid applications, all original, divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, substitute or reissue applications and patents applied for or granted therefor in the United States of America and all other countries; and the undersigned for him and his legal representatives, heirs and assigns does hereby agree and covenant, without further remuneration, to execute and deliver all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue and other applications for Letters Patent on said invention and all assignments and powers of attorney thereof to said Assignee or its assigns, to communicate to said Assignee or its legal representatives all facts known to the undersigned respecting said invention, to testify in any interferences or other legal proceedings in which any of said applications or patents may become involved, to sign all lawful papers, make all rightful oaths and to do generally everything necessary to aid said Assignee, its successors, assigns and nominees in obtaining patent protection on said invention in all countries, the expenses incident to said applications to be borne and paid by said Assignee.
