ASSIGNMENT DOCUMENT

WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR is desirous of transferring the entire right, title, and interest in the subject matter identified herein and ASSIGNEE is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title, and interest in said subject matter.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged:

I. Grant of Rights. ASSIGNOR hereby sells, assigns, and transfers to ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, the full and exclusive right, title, and interest (including all causes of action relating thereto) for the United States and all foreign countries, in and to the following subject matter: 60/521,436 PORTABLE ANTENNA POSITIONER APPARATUS AND METHOD (inventors Spencer L. Webb and David Martin), all divisional, continuing, improvement, substitute, renewal, reissue, and all other directly related applications for Letters Patent which have been or shall be filed in the United States and all foreign countries on any inventions or improvements contained in said Applications; and in and to all original and reissued patents which have been or shall be issued in the United States and all foreign countries on said improvements or Applications; and in and to all rights of priority resulting from the filing of said Applications (this Section I referred to hereinafter as "Patents" or "Patent Rights").

II. Obligations of the Parties. ASSIGNOR agrees that ASSIGNEE may apply for and receive Letters Patent for said Patents in its own name and hereby authorizes and requests the Director of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office to issue all United States Patents granted or derived from said Applications to ASSIGNEE; and that, when requested, without charge to (but at the expense of ASSIGNEE) ASSIGNOR will carry out in good faith the intent and purpose of this Assignment by: (a) executing all divisional, continuing, improvement, substitute, renewal, reissue, and all other patent applications on any and all of said Patents; (b) executing all rightful oaths, assignments, powers of attorney and other papers; (c) communicating to ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns, and representatives, all known facts relating to said Patents and the history thereof; and (d) generally do everything possible which ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns or representatives shall consider desirable for aiding in securing and maintaining proper patent protection for said Patents or Patent Rights and for vesting title to said Patents and all Applications for patents, in ASSIGNEE.
