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RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST

THIS RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST, dated December 16, 2005, is hereby executed by THE CIT GROUP/BUSINESS CREDIT, INC. (as successor by merger to The CIT Group/Credit Finance, Inc.), a New York corporation (the "Assignee"), and shall be delivered to TSI TELSIS, INC., a Maryland corporation (the "Assignor").

WHEREAS, Assignor did execute and deliver to Assignee certain Patent, Trademark and License Mortgages (the "Security Agreements") pursuant to which Assignor granted to Assignee a collateral assignment of, and security interest in, certain patents and trademarks of Assignor;

WHEREAS, the Security Agreements were recorded in the United States Patent and Trademark Office at (i) Reel 001886, Frame 0575 on April 15, 1999 (with respect to the trademarks); and (ii) Reel 009855, Frame 0265 on March 29, 1999 (with respect to the patents), and cover certain United States trademarks and patents set forth on Schedule I, attached hereto and made a part hereof, and all rights relating thereto (collectively the "Intellectual Property"); and

WHEREAS the Security Agreements were executed as security for certain loans made by Assignee to Assignor, and such loans have been fully paid and satisfied.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignee does hereby terminate Assignee's security interest and hereby assigns, sells and transfers unto Assignor Assignee's entire right, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Property, together with that part of the goodwill of Assignee's business connected with the use of and symbolized by the Intellectual Property, and together with all registrations and applications relating thereto, and does hereby further cancel and terminate the Security Agreements, declare the same null and void, of no further force and effect, and further states that Assignee has no further or continuing right, title or interest in or to any of the Intellectual Property.



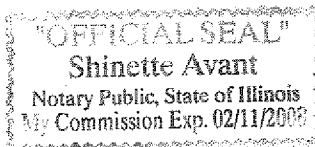


