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
CORRECTIVE ASSIGNMENT

The purpose of this assignment is to correct an error in the named assignee appearing in the assignments from PHILIPS SEMICONDUCTORS, INC., as assignor, to KONINKLIJKE PHILIPS ELECTRONICS N.V., as assignee, which were recorded on February 13, 2003 at Reel 013753/Frame 0498 of the assignment records of the United States Patent and Trademark Office. The named assignee in those assignments should have been KONINKLIJKE PHILIPS ELECTRONICS N.V. and TEXAS INSTRUMENTS INCORPORATED – NOT solely KONINKLIJKE PHILIPS ELECTRONICS N.V.

Correction of the assignment is necessary because VLSI Technology Incorporated and Dot Wireless Incorporated had previously agreed that the invention resulting in application Serial No. 09/322,293 would be jointly owned by the two companies. No assignment, however, was ever submitted to the USPTO reflecting said joint ownership of application 09/322,293. Later, Philips Semiconductors Incorporated acquired VLSI Technology Incorporated on July 2, 1999 and changed the name of VLSI Technology Incorporated to Philips Semiconductors VLSI Incorporated. Philips Semiconductors VLSI Incorporated was merged into Philips Semiconductors Incorporated on January 1, 2000. Philips Semiconductors Incorporated assigned the invention relating to application Serial No. 09/322,293 to Koninklijke Philips Electronics N.V., on February 5, 2003. Texas Instruments Incorporated acquired Dot Wireless Incorporated and the name of Dot Wireless Incorporated was changed to Texas Instruments San Diego on August 31, 2000. Texas Instruments San Diego was merged into Texas Instrument Incorporated on August 31, 2002. Accordingly, Koninklijke Philips Electronics N.V. is the successor in interest to VLSI Technology Incorporated and Texas Instruments Incorporated is the successor interest to Dot Wireless Incorporated. The assignment record for U.S. Patent 6,542,492 B1 should be corrected to reflect joint ownership of the patent by Koninklijke Philips Electronics N.V. and Texas Instrument Incorporated.

WHEREFORE:

KONINKLIJKE PHILIPS ELECTRONICS N.V., a corporation having a place of business at Groenweoudseweg 1, 5621 BA Eindhoven, NL, acting as Assignor herein, hereby assigns an undivided joint ownership interest to TEXAS INSTRUMENTS INCORPORATED, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, having a place of business at 7839 Churchill Way, MS 3999, Dallas, Texas 75251, and their respective successors, assigns and legal representatives, as Assignees, to all right, title, and interest received by KONINKLIJKE PHILIPS ELECTRONICS N.V., from PHILIPS SEMICONDUCTORS, INC., under the assignments recorded at Reel 013753/Frame 0498 in the invention entitled METHOD AND SYSTEM OF INITIALIZING STATE METRICS FOR TRAFFIC, PAGING, AND SYNC CHANNELS TO ENHANCE VITERBI DECODER PERFORMANCE and which is the subject of U.S. Patent No. 6,542,492 B1 thereby giving TEXAS INSTRUMENTS INCORPORATED a joint ownership interest with KONINKLIJKE PHILIPS ELECTRONICS N.V. in and to said invention and in and to said U.S. Patent No. 6,542,492 B1.
