

PHOTOMULTIPLIER DEVELOPMENT MANAGER

Job Description

Working within an ISO9001 environment and reporting to the Technical Director, the Photomultiplier Development Manager is responsible for the design, development and introduction into manufacture of new and improved photomultipliers, electron multipliers and vacuum photodiodes.

Activities include:-

- To manage development staff and projects on a day to day basis within agreed budgets and timescales . Management responsibilities are defined in ETL's method instruction MI 02402 .
- To make staff appraisals and organise staff training as appropriate to the development tasks and within budget limits.
- To meet legislative requirements including product safety, product liability and COSHH.
- To develop new devices, processes and techniques from electron optics, through to electro optical testing including thin film vacuum deposition and mechanical design.
- To improve existing designs, processes and techniques via the experimental system.
- To liaise with customers to define requirements and detailed specifications.
- To make regular Patent and Literature searches related to our products and technologies.
- To make patent applications on behalf of the company related to novel devices, processes, techniques and materials as directed by the company from time to time.
- To select components and materials and liaise with suppliers to establish specifications and external sourcing.
- To perform other duties as advised by the Technical Director.

Section 39: Right to employees' inventions

39.- (1) Notwithstanding anything in any rule of law, an invention made by an employee shall, as between him and his employer, be taken to belong to his employer for the purposes of this Act and all other purposes if -

- (a) it was made in the course of the normal duties of the employee or in the course of duties falling outside his normal duties, but specifically assigned to him, and the circumstances in either case were such that an invention might reasonably be expected to result from the carrying out of his duties; or
- (b) the invention was made in the course of the duties of the employee and, at the time of making the invention, because of the nature of his duties and the particular responsibilities arising from the nature of his duties he had a special obligation to further the interests of the employer's undertaking.

(2) Any other invention made by an employee shall, as between him and his employer, be taken for those purposes to belong to the employee .

(3) Where by virtue of this section an invention belongs, as between him and his employer, to an employee, nothing done -

- (a) by or on behalf of the employee or any person claiming under him for the purposes of pursuing an application for a patent, or
- (b) by any person for the purpose of performing or working the invention, shall be taken to infringe any copyright or design right to which, as between him and his employer, his employer is entitled in any model or document relating to the invention.
