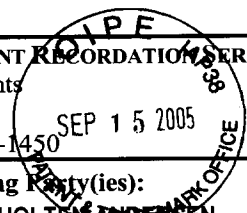

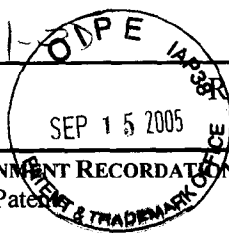

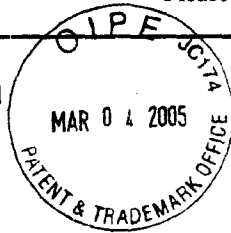

HVIDOVRE HOSPITAL, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, fifty percent (50%) undivided right, title and interest and to the aforesaid invention and/or Application, including any and all improvements and/or modifications to the aforesaid invention and/or Application, and in and to any and all patent applications and/or Letters Patent of the United States or any other country related to the invention, the Application, and/or any and all improvements and/or modifications to the aforesaid invention and Application, including but not limited to, provisional applications, conversions to utility applications, continuations, continuations-in-part, CPAs, RCEs, reissues, reexaminations, extensions, substitutes, renewals and divisions which may be granted therefor and all rights to claim priority in whole or in part on the basis of the Application or any patent application identified herein.
