This limited liability company is organized for the purpose of obtaining and managing certain patent rights and other intellectual property and proprietary rights in and to, the licensing or leasing of and other valuable considerations for a door anchor lock system patent and related invention(s) and to conduct any other business that is authorized by law.

4. Members will spend such time working in the company business as is mutually agreed upon by and between the members.

5. Management responsibilities will be shared by the members by percent of ownership and an effort will be made to operate under a mutually agreeable plan.

6. The principal place of business of the company and the company's registered office shall be at 12605 W. North Avenue #296, Brookfield, WI 53005, and any of the members may inspect or copy the records at any reasonable time. The annual financial statement and balance sheet shall be prepared by a certified public accountant at the close of each taxable year and be provided to each of the members hereto.

8. All expenses incurred in connection with the company will be classified as "capital expenses" or as "operating expenses" or as "personal expenses". Expenses will be assigned to whichever classification is appropriate according to the regulations of the Internal Revenue Service.

9. Capital expenses will be paid by the members in proportion to their respective contributions to the company's physical assets as of the time such payment is made.

on the oft mentioned date 7/9/02

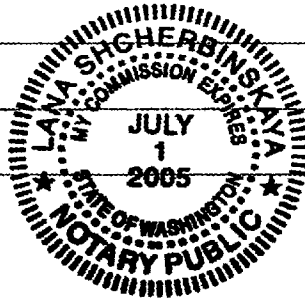
In the event of mine and Nancy's demise
