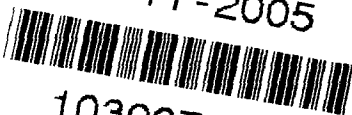

COOLING SYSTEM FOR A ROTARY SCREW COMPRESSOR


which is set forth in an application for Letters Patent in the United States executed on even date herewith; Attorney Docket No. 67,036-082; B05277-SUL.
