ACT

To provide for the continued existence of the Council for Mineral Technology and for the management thereof by a Board; and for matters connected therewith.

(Affirmed and signed by the acting State President.)
(Assented to 14 March 1989.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Definitions

1. In this Act, unless the context otherwise indicates:—
 - (i) "Board" means the Board referred to in section 5; (u)
 - (ii) "chairman" means the chairman of the Board appointed in terms of section 5; (a)
 - (iii) "financial year" means the period from 1 April in any year to 31 March in the next succeeding year; (j)
 - (iv) "fixed date" means the date fixed in terms of section 21; (viii)
 - (v) "Minister" means the Minister to whom the administration of this Act has been assigned in terms of section 18; (iii)
 - (vi) "Mintek" means the Council for Mineral Technology referred to in section 2; (iv)
 - (vii) "president" means the person appointed in terms of section 9 as the chief executive officer of Mintek; (v)
 - (viii) "regulation" means a regulation in force in terms of this Act; (vi)
 - (ix) "this Act" includes a regulation; (ix)

Continued existence of Council for Mineral Technology

2. (1) The Council for Mineral Technology established by section 2 of the Mineral 20 Technology Act, 1981 (Act No. 84 of 1981), shall, notwithstanding the repeal of that Act by this Act, continue to exist as a juristic person known as Mintek.
- (2) The registrar of deeds concerned shall make the entries or endorsements in or on any relevant register, title deed or other document in his office or submitted to him which he may deem necessary in order to give effect to the provisions of 25 subsection (1), and no office fee or other charge shall be payable in respect of any such entry or endorsement.

Objects of Mintek

3. The objects of Mintek are through research, development and technology transfer, to promote mineral technology, and so foster the establishment and 30 expansion of industries in the field of minerals and products derived therefrom.

Functions, powers and duties of Mintek

4. (1) The functions of Mintek shall be to achieve its objects with the means at its disposal, and for the purposes of achieving those objects Mintek may:—
 - (a) undertake research, development and technology transfer in connection 35 with—
 - (i) the better utilization of the mineral resources of the Republic;
