I, Norman F. Starkey, being duly sworn, deposes and say,

1. I am individual whose address is 1710 Ivar Avenue, Suite 1100, Los Angeles, California and I am over the age of 18.


2. On or about January 3, 1989 the Superior Court of California for the County of San Luis Obispo granted in its Judgment of Final Distribution on Waiver of Accounting and for Allowance of Attorney's Fees for Ordinary Services and Judgment of Final Distribution (hereinafter the "Judgment"), a true and accurate copy of which is being submitted concurrently with this Affidavit.

3. Under the terms of a trust agreement executed by Mr. Hubbard, I was also appointed trustee of an inter vivos trust to administer property that Mr. Hubbard chose to transfer to the trust upon his death. Under the terms of Mr. Hubbard's will and pursuant to the Judgment, certain property was thereafter transferred to me as trustee. The transferred property included "any property not now known or discovered, that was owned by decedent at the time of his death or in which his estate has acquired or may hereafter acquire any interest" as set forth in Paragraph 6 of the Judgment.

4. In or about November 29, 1993, and acting as trustee pursuant to said trust agreement, I transferred all the property held in trust to the Church of Spiritual Technology having an address at 419 N. Larchmont, No. 86, Los Angeles, California 90004 (hereinafter "CST"). Said transferred property included any and all rights in Mr. Hubbard's inventions, whether known or unknown, that was owned by him at the time of his death or which his estate thereafter acquired, as set forth in Paragraph 3 above. This included the invention illustrated and described in a patent application assigned attorney docket number L4069-01400P and entitled "System for Measuring and Indicating Changes in the Resistance of a Living Body".

5. To the extent that a written assignment of Mr. Hubbard's rights in the foregoing invention is required, I hereby confirm said prior assignment to CST, and

retroactively assign *nun pro tunc*, to CST all of the right, title and interest in and to said invention, including all patent rights and all international priority, and I hereby authorize and request the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks and all non-U.S. patent offices to issue all patents relating to the Patent Rights to CST and/or its successors and assigns.
