ASSIGNMENT

2. Assignor covenants and agrees to cooperate with Assignee to enable Assignee to enjoy to the fullest extent the right title and interest herein conveyed in the United States and other countries.

3. The terms, covenants and conditions of this assignment shall inure to the benefit of Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon Assignor, her heirs, assigns, successors and other legal representatives.

4. Assignor hereby warrants and represents that she has not entered and will not enter into any assignment, contract, or understanding in conflict herewith.
