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ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION

WHEREAS I (we), **David W. Byers** and **Gary A. Hall** and **Colen G. Kennell** and **Aleksander B. Macander** and **Judah H. Milgram** and **Jason D. Strickland** of Arlington, Virginia and King George, Virginia and University Park, Maryland and Rockville, Maryland and Hyattsville, Maryland and Gaithersburg, Maryland, respectively, while employed by the Government of the United States of America, hereinafter referred to as the **Government**, have made an invention entitled **Unmanned Aerial Vehicle for Logistical Delivery**, identified as Navy Case No. 84,290, and described in application for Letters Patent of the United States of America as executed by me (us) on 4/26/04, 2004; and
