This quit claim is to Wendy J. Engel as described above as the first assignment.

Wendy J. Engel quit claims and by these presents does hereby quit claim any and all right she, her successors and assigns, may have, including the right to sue and collect for past damages, in and to U.S. Application No. 10/816,014. This quit claim is to Raymond B. Ryan as described above as the second assignment.

Both of the above quit claims respectively constitute a sale, assignment, transfer, and set over, and by these presents do hereby sell, assign, transfer, and set over, unto the other, its successors, and assigns, the entire right, title and interest in, to, and under any and all inventions disclosed or described in the above-identified respective patent applications and any and all rights thereto, including the above-identified respective patent applications, any and all United States and foreign patents which may be granted pursuant thereto, and any and all United States and foreign applications, continuations,




