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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, JOHN WROBLESKI, a citizen of The United States of America, residing at 190 Whitehall Road, Andover, New Jersey 07821, and FRED RICHARD SCHOLER, a citizen of The United States of America, residing at 47 Brooktree Road, East Windsor, New Jersey 08520, hereinafter referred to as ASSIGNORS, have invented certain new and useful improvements in a PUTTY COMPOSITION AND METHOD, for which we have respectively executed and filed an application for Letters Patents with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on even date herewith;

AND WE HEREBY covenant that we have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that we have not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith.

AND WE HEREBY further covenant and agree that we will communicate to the ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to us respecting the improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do

everything possible to aid the ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for the improvements in all countries.


