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ASSIGNMENT

Neff's rights, title, and interest in and to the inventions that form the subject matter of the patent application identified in Exhibit C, attached, and in and to any patents issuing from said United States patent application (all of said inventions and the United States patent application (collectively referred to as the "Joint Patent Rights"), and in and to all United States and foreign divisional, provisional, continuing, renewal, reissue, or other patent applications based upon or related to the Patent Rights, and any United States and foreign patents issuing from any of said United States and foreign divisional, provisional, continuing, renewal, reissue, or other patent applications based upon or related to the Joint Patent Rights,

WHEREAS, the Patent Rights and Joint Patent Rights are collectively referred to as the Neff Patent Rights.

WHEREAS, NEFF is also the owner of certain know-how that is necessary or useful to practice the aforementioned inventions, including, but not limited to, confidential and non-confidential, published and unpublished, research and development information and technical data, computer data and other data from simulations and/or calculations received from the Estate of Samuel R. Neff, all of which is hereinafter referred to as "Estate Know-How";

WHEREAS the Neff Patent Rights and all United States and foreign divisional, provisional, continuing, renewal, reissue, or other patent applications based upon or related to the Neff Patent Rights, and any United States and foreign patents issuing from any of said United States and foreign divisional, provisional, continuing, renewal, reissue, or other patent applications based upon or related to the Neff Patent Rights, and the Estate Know-How are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Neff Intellectual Property Rights" (hereinafter "NIPR"); and

WHEREAS, NEURO DIAGNOSTIC DEVICES, INC., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware and having an office and place of business at 3701 Market Street, Third Floor, Philadelphia, PA 19104 (hereinafter "NDD"), is desirous of acquiring all of NEFF's rights, title, and interest in and to the NIPR.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, NEFF and NDD agree as follows:

1. NEFF hereby sells, assigns, and transfers to NDD, all of NEFF's rights, title and interest in and throughout the United States and its territories and all countries foreign thereto, in

and to the NIPR, including all rights to sue others for past acts of infringement of the NIPR and to retain all revenues received from others for past acts of infringement of the NIPR.

2. NEFF hereby requests that any and all United States and foreign Letters Patents that may be granted upon patent applications forming a part of the Neff Patent Rights be issued to NDS, and that this Assignment be indexed against any and all of such United States and foreign Letters Patents forming a part of the Neff Patent Rights.

3. NEFF further agrees on behalf of her successors, assigns and legally-bound predecessors to execute or have executed without further consideration, any further legal documents, legal oaths, papers and any further assignments, and any releases, reissues, renewals or other applications for Letters Patent that may be deemed necessary by NDD, or by NDD's successors-in-interest or assigns, fully to secure to NDD, or to NDD's successors-in-interest or assigns, NEFF's interest aforesaid in and to the NIPR.

4. NEFF further agrees to provide NDD or its successors or assigns or a legal representative thereof, upon request and at the expense of NDD or its successors or assigns or a legal representative thereof, all information and evidence in her possession, custody, or control received from the Estate of Samuel R. Neff relating to the making and practicing of the NIPR, including, if reasonably necessary, testifying in any legal proceeding relating to said information and evidence received from the Estate of Samuel R. Neff relating to the making and practicing of the NIPR.

5. NEFF hereby warrants that no assignment, sale, agreement, or encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this Assignment.

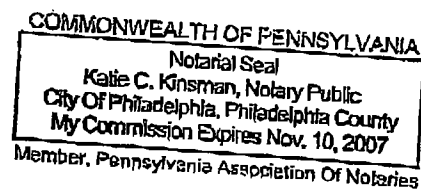
