Sention further agrees for itself and its executors and administrators that Sention will without demanding any further consideration therefor, at the request but at the expense of CNS Acquisitions, LLC, do any lawful and just acts, including the execution and acknowledgment of instruments, that may be or become necessary for obtaining, sustaining, or reissuing said Letters Patent as may be granted from said Patent Applications, and for maintaining and perfecting CNS Acquisitions, LLC's right, its successors, assigns and legal representatives to said Letters Patent including the execution of applications for patents in foreign countries, and the execution of any future applications including substitution, reissue, divisional or continuation applications, and
