
WHEREAS, Assignee desires to obtain all right, title and interest in and to the Patents and Pending Patent Applications.

2. The Assignor hereby undertakes to give its assistance to the Assignee, and take any and all other further actions necessary, to effect the assignment of the Patents and Pending Patent Applications to Assignee
3. This Patent Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which counterpart, when so executed and delivered, shall be deemed to be an original, and all of which counterparts, taken together, shall constitute one and the same instrument even if all parties have not executed the same counterpart. 
