ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION

WHEREAS, CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS INTERNATIONAL GmbH, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Germany and having a business address of Checkpoint Systems GmbH, Von-Humboldt-Strasse, Heppenheim, Hessen, Germany 64632 owns all right, title and interest in and to an invention in a METHOD AND SYSTEM FOR TRACKING ITEMS IN A SHIPPING FACILITY upon which a U.S. utility application has been or shortly will be filed that claims priority to a provisional application of the same name, filed December 3, 2004, as application serial no. 60/633,096.

all countries foreign thereto which have been granted or may be granted on said invention or any part thereof, or on any Acquired Improvements, and in and to and similar protective rights granted on said foreign applications, and in and to the right to claim any applicable priority rights arising from or required for said foreign applications under the terms of any applicable conventions, treaties, statutes, or regulations, said foreign applications to be filed and issued in the name of CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS, INC., or its designee insofar as permitted by applicable law.

CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS INTERNATIONAL GmbH further agrees that all necessary records of CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS INTERNATIONAL GmbH to establish priority of invention in any interference or similar proceeding will be made available at no additional charge to CHECKPOINT SYSTEMS, INC. in the event such records are needed in connection with the assigned application for Letters Patent.
