Whereas Bruker AXS Inc., a Delaware corporation having a place of business at 5465 E. Cheryl Parkway Madison, Wisconsin 53711, which, together with its successors and assigns, is hereinafter called "Assignee," is desirous of acquiring the title, rights, benefits and privileges hereinafter recited;
