## ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS AND PATENT APPLICATIONS

ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS AND PATENT APPLICATIONS (this "Assignment"), dated the 22 day of DECEMBER, 2005, between Pi Electronics Corporation, a Texas corporation ("Assignor"), and Pitney Bowes Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Assignee").

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Asset Purchase Agreement, dated as of 22 day of DECEMBER 2005, (the "Asset Purchase Agreement"), Assignor has agreed to assign, transfer, convey and deliver to Assignee and Assignee has agreed to acquire from Assignor the Assets (as defined in the Asset Purchase Agreement); and

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of all right, title and interest in and to the Assets listed in Annex A attached hereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual representations, covenants and agreements contained herein and in the Asset Purchase Agreement and the other Transaction Documents, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor and Assignee, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

1. Assignor hereby sells, sets over, assigns, grants, delivers, transfers and conveys to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns all right, title and interest in and to all Assets and all continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, reissues, re-examinations, substitutions, extensions and foreign counterparts thereof which are owned by Assignor, including, without limitation, the right to petition, sue or otherwise seek and recover damages, profits and any other remedy (monetary, injunctive, declaratory or other) for any past, present or future infringement.

2. Assignor warrants that the Assets and Assignor's interest in the Assets is free and clear of any Encumbrances, and that it has full and complete power and authority to sell, transfer and assign such Assets to Assignee.

3. Assignor hereby agrees to authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and the appropriate officers of all other jurisdictions in which any of the Assets are registered or in which an application for registration is pending, to record the title of and issue letters patent to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, as owner of all right, title and interest in and to the subject Assets.

4. The Assignor agrees that it will execute and deliver or cause to be executed and delivered, to any of the Assignee or its legal representatives, any other or additional releases, documents, certificates, powers or other writings prepared by Assignee, and take all additional actions as may be necessary to transfer the Assets to Assignee, to effectuate and validate this Assignment, to record this Assignment with the United States Patent and Trademark Office and the appropriate agencies and offices of all jurisdictions in which one or more of the Assets is or

may be registered or in which applications for registration of one or more of the Assets are pending, under the relevant laws of the United States or any other jurisdictions.

5. All capitalized terms used herein and not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Asset Purchase Agreement.

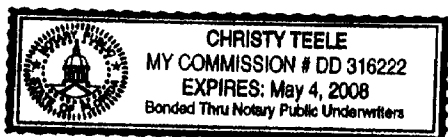


