



WHEREAS, PROFESSOR MINO GREEN of 55 Gerard Road, London SW13 9QH ("Professor Green") is listed as the inventor of U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 10/049,736 dated July 22, 2002, that application being the entry into the national phase of International Application PCT/GB00/03202 filed on 17 August 2000;

WHEREAS, Professor Green executed an assignment document on 8 July 2002 assigning his rights in the above-identified application to IMPERIAL COLLEGE OF SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND MEDICINE, a corporation of the country of the United Kingdom having a place of business at Exhibition Road, London SW7 2AZ United Kingdom ("The College"), that document having been recorded by the United States Patent and Trademark Office on 22 July 2002 at Reel 013419 beginning at Frame 0827;
