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

NOTICE OF SECURITY INTEREST
U.S. PATENTS

WHEREAS, United Fixtures Company, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("UFC"), Interlake Material Handling, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Interlake"), Interlake Acquisition Co., a Delaware corporation ("Merger Corp.") (UFC, Interlake and Merger Corp. are collectively, the "Borrowers"), and Conco-Tellus, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("CTI") (UFC, Interlake, Merger Corp., and CTI are each a "Grantor" and collectively, the "Grantors"), own the patents listed on the annexed Schedule A, which patents are registered, to the extent indicated, in the United States Patent and Trademark Office (the "Patents");

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Credit and Security Agreement, dated of even date herewith, by and among the Borrowers, the Guarantors (as defined in the Credit Agreement), Roynat Business Capital, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("*Roynat*") and such other Persons that are now or which hereafter become a party hereto as Lenders (collectively, the "*Lenders*" and individually, a "*Lender*"), and Roynat as administrative agent and collateral agent for the Lenders (Roynat, in such capacity, the "*Grantee*") (as amended, modified or supplemented from time to time, the "Credit Agreement"), the Borrowers are obligated to the Grantee, and the Grantors have entered into that certain Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement, dated of even date herewith (the "Security Agreement") in favor of the Grantee; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Security Agreement, the Grantors have granted to the Grantee (for itself and for the benefit of the Lenders), a security interest in all right, title and interest of the Grantors in and to the Patents, and the letters patent and applications for registration thereof, and all proceeds thereof, including, without limitation, any royalties, claims for infringement and proceeds of sale or other disposition thereof (the "Patent Collateral") to secure the payment and performance of the Obligations (as defined in the Security Agreement).

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound hereby, the Grantors, pursuant to the Security Agreement, did and do grant to the Grantee (for itself and for the benefit of the Lenders) a security interest in the Patent Collateral to secure prompt payment and performance of the Obligations.

The Grantors do hereby further acknowledge and affirm that the rights and remedies of the Grantee (for itself and for the benefit of the Lenders) with respect to the security interest in the Patent Collateral granted hereby and under the Security Agreement are more fully set forth in the Security Agreement, the terms and provisions of which are hereby incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth in this Assignment.
