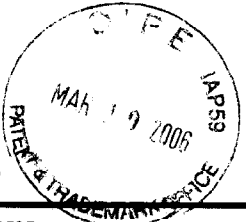

ASSIGNMENT OF UNITED STATES PATENT APPLICATION


WHEREAS, we, TORSTEN PETERS and MATTHIAS RUDOLPH, of Haenigsen, Germany and Hannover, Germany, respectively, have invented certain new and useful improvements in A MULTI-VENDOR AGENT FOR A SELF-SERVICE TERMINAL, Docket No. 12316, for which we have executed an application for Letters Patent of the United States on same date herewith, respectively; and


