ASSIGNMENT AND AGREEMENT
Joint Inventors

WHEREAS, Frank T. Morrison, County of Anne Arundel, State of Maryland; Thomas P. Carter, County of Montgomery, State of Maryland hereinafter called the "Assignors", has invented certain new and useful improvements in an IMPROVED HEAT TRANSFER TUBE ASSEMBLY WITH SERPENTINE CIRCUITS for a full description of which reference is here made to an application for Letters Patent of the United States and identified as attorney's Case No. BAC171, executed of even date herewith; and

WHEREAS, Baltimore Aircoil Company, Incorporated, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, having an office and place of business at 7600 Dorsey Run Road, Jessup, Maryland, 20794 hereinafter called the "Assignee", is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to said invention, the application above identified, and in, to and under Letters Patent which may be obtained for said invention, as hereinafter more fully set forth.

Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, to the full end of the term or terms for which any and all of said Letters Patent for said invention may issued.

And the said Assignors do hereby covenant and agree, for themselves and their legal representatives, that they will assist their said Assignee in the prosecution of the application herein identified; in the making and prosecution of any other application for Letters Patent that the said Assignee may elect to make covering the invention herein identified, as hereinbefore set forth; in vesting in the said Assignee like exclusive title in and to all such other applications and Letters Patent; and in the prosecution of any interference which may arise involving said invention, or any application or Letters Patent herein contemplated; and that they will execute and deliver to the said Assignee any and all additional papers which may be requested by the said Assignee to fully carry out the terms of this Assignment.

And the said Assignors do hereby covenant with said Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives that the rights and property herein conveyed are free and clear of any adverse assignment, grant, mortgage, license or other encumbrance, and that they have the full right to convey to the same in manner and form as herein expressed.
