ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Bill Gallentine, Myron D. Tupper, and Ovidiu Salagean, (hereinafter termed "Inventors"), a resident of Hood River, Oregon, Boring, Oregon, and Hillsboro, Oregon, respectively, have invented certain new and useful improvements in Hydraulically Powered Gipping Tool, and have executed a United States Patent Application disclosing and identifying the invention; and

court actions; provided however, that the expense incurred by said Inventor in providing such cooperation shall be paid for by said Assignee.
