ASSIGNMENT

Assignment made this the Ninth day of June, 2006, by joint inventors Allen Tison and J. RECITALS

A. Inventors have invented certain new and useful improvements concerning a Switch Device and Method for Controlling a Sprayer for which U.S. patent application number 10/828,061 is pending and ready for issuance as letters patent of the United States, the invention being described in and identified by the specification in the application filed April 20, 2004.


