Dear Mr. Bielawa:

This is to confirm, that the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC) received your March 2, 2005 letter concerning the title change by Chase Manhattan Bank USA, National Association accompanied by the appropriate amendment to the Bank's articles of association. The OCC has recorded that as of March 1, 2005, the title of Chase Manhattan Bank USA, National Association, Newark, Delaware, Charter Nr. 23160, was changed to Chase Bank USA, National Association.

As a result of the Garn-St. Germain Depository Institutions act of 1982, the OCC is no longer responsible for the approval of national bank name changes nor does it maintain official records on the use of alternate titles. The retention of the rights to any previously used title is the responsibility of the Bank's board of directors. Legal counsel should determine whether or not the new title, or previously used title, could be challenged by competing institutions under the provisions of federal or state law.

This letter, and the activities and communications by OCC employees in connection with the change of title, do not constitute a contract, express or implied, or any other obligation binding upon the OCC, the U.S., any agency or entity of the U.S., or any officer or employee of the U.S., and do not affect the ability of the OCC to exercise its supervisory, regulatory and examination authorities under applicable law and regulations. The foregoing may not be waived or modified by any employee or agent of the OCC or the U.S.
