AND CTT does hereby covenant and warrant that it has the full right to sell, assign, transfer, and convey it's entire right and interest in and to Patent Family, herein assigned free and clear of all licenses, encumbrances, and liens whatsoever, and that it has not executed and will not execute any instruments in conflict herewith.

AND CTT further covenants and agrees that it will at any time, upon request, communicate to said Trustees, it's successors, assigns or legal representatives, any facts relating to Patent Family, or the history thereof, known to CTT.

AND, CTT further covenants that the foregoing provisions shall be binding upon its heirs, legal representatives, administrators, or assigns.
