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ASSIGNMENT

THIS ASSIGNMENT, having an effective date as of June 30, 2003, made by us, Shu-Shaw Wang, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 1803 Longbranch Court, Arlington, Texas 76012 US; and Marilyn P. Green, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 1581 Route 202, #124, Pomona, New York 10970 US;

WITNESSETH: That,

WHEREAS, we are the inventors of certain new and useful improvements in **APPARATUS, AND ASSOCIATED METHOD, FOR TESTING A MOBILE TERMINAL IN TEST CONDITIONS THAT EMULATE AN OPERATING ENVIRONMENT** for which an international application under the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) has been filed in the Receiving Office of the United States Patent and Trademark Office and for which a U.S. application has been separately filed in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. The international application bears Application No. PCT/US2004/021262 and was filed on June 30, 2004. The U.S. application bears Application No. 10/562,841 and was filed on December 29, 2005. Both International Application No. PCT/US2004/021262 and U.S. Application No. 10/562,841 claim priority of U.S. Application No. 60/483,663, filed June 30, 2003. Both the international application and the U.S. application will hereinafter be referred to as the subject applications.

WHEREAS, NOKIA CORPORATION, a corporation of Finland, having a principal place of business at Keilalahdentie 4, FIN-02150 Espoo, Finland, hereinafter referred to as assignee, is desirous of confirming its ownership of the entire right, title and interest in and to said invention as described in the subject applications, and in and to any and all Letters Patent which shall be granted therefor in the United States of America and all foreign countries;

NOW, THEREFORE, To Whom It May Concern, be it known that for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, we have sold and by these presents do hereby sell, assign, transfer and convey unto the said assignee, its successors and assigns, the entire right, title and interest in and to the said invention and the subject applications, and in and to any and all continuations, continuations-in-part, or divisions thereof, and in and to any and all Letters Patent of the United States of America and all foreign countries or reissues or extensions thereof which may be granted therefor or thereon, for the full end of the

term for which said Letters Patent may be granted, together with the right to claim the priority of the subject applications in all foreign countries in accordance with the International Convention, the same to be held and enjoyed by said assignee, its successors and assigns, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by us if this assignment and sale had not been made.

We hereby request that said Letters Patent be issued in accordance with this assignment.

We further covenant and agree that, at the time of the execution and delivery of these presents, we possess full title to the invention and the subject applications above-mentioned, and that we have the unencumbered right and authority to make this assignment.

We further covenant and agree to bind our heirs, legal representatives and assigns, promptly to communicate to said assignee or its representatives any facts known to us relating to said invention, to testify in any interference or legal proceedings involving said invention, to execute any additional papers which may be requested to confirm the right of the assignee, its representatives, successors or assigns to secure patent or similar protection for the said invention in all countries and to vest in the assignee complete title to the said invention and Letters Patent, without further compensation, but at the expense of said assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives.
