**APPARATUS AND METHOD FOR CONTROLLED APPLICATION OF REACTIVE VAPORS
TO PRODUCE THIN FILMS AND COATINGS**

for which an application for Letters Patent in the United States is filed concurrently herewith; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey D. NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of good and valuable consideration acknowledged by said Assignors to have been received in full from said Joint Assignees, with rights of survivorship:

1. Said Assignors hereby sell, assign, transfer and convey to Joint Assignees, with rights of survivorship the full and exclusive right, title and interest (a) in and to said Application and said Invention; (b) in and to all rights to apply for patents on said Invention in any and all countries pursuant to the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property or otherwise; (c) in and to any and all Applications filed and any and all Patents granted on said Invention in any and all countries and groups of countries, including each and every Application filed and each and every Patent granted on any application which is a division, substitution, or continuation of said Application; and (d) in and to each and every reissue or extension of any of said Patents.

2. Said Assignors hereby covenant and agree to cooperate with said Joint Assignees, with rights of survivorship to enable said Joint Assignees, with rights of survivorship to enjoy to the fullest extent the right, title and interest to said Invention herein conveyed in any and all countries and groups of countries. Such cooperation by said Assignors shall include prompt production of pertinent facts and documents, giving testimony, execution of petitions, oaths, specifications, declarations or


other papers, and other assistance all to the extent deemed necessary or desirable by said Joint Assignees, with rights of survivorship (a) for perfecting in said Joint Assignees, with rights of survivorship the right, title and interest herein conveyed; (b) for prosecuting any of said applications; (c) for filing and prosecuting substitute, divisional, continuing or additional applications covering said Invention; (d) for filing and prosecuting applications for reissuance of any of said Patents; (e) for interference or other priority proceedings involving said Invention; and (f) for legal proceedings involving said Invention and any application therefor and any Patents granted thereon, including without limitation opposition proceedings, cancellation proceedings, priority contests, public use proceedings, infringement actions and court actions; provided, however, that the expense incurred by said Assignors in providing such cooperation shall be paid for by said Joint Assignees, with rights of survivorship.

3. The term and covenants of this agreement shall inure to the benefit of said Joint Assignees, with rights of survivorship, and shall be binding upon said Assignors, their respective heirs, legal representatives and assigns.



4. Said Assignors hereby warrant and represent that they have not entered and will not enter into any assignment, contract, or understanding in conflict herewith.


