PATENT ASSIGNMENT

This PATENT ASSIGNMENT ("Assignment") is made and entered into as of January 31, 2005 ("Effective Date") by and between The American National Red Cross, a nonprofit, charitable corporation chartered by an act of the United States Congress of January 5, 1905, as amended, codified at 36 U.S.C. § 300101 *et seq.*, also known as the American Red Cross, headquartered at 2025 E St., NW, Washington, D.C. 20006 ("Assignor") and Kamada Ltd., having an address of Kiryat Weizmann, Rehovot 76327, Israel ("Assignee").

BACKGROUND

- A. Assignor and Assignee have entered into that certain Confidential Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release effective November 18, 2004 ("Settlement Agreement"), which, along with the promises contained herein, constitute mutual consideration for the promises herein;
- B. Assignor is the owner of certain inventions, as described and claimed in the issued patent and patent application listed in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein (collectively, "Inventions"). The Inventions, together with any and all patent applications that may be filed thereon, any and all patents that may issue therefrom and any and all continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues, substitutions, reexaminations or foreign counterparts thereof and all know-how associated therewith are collectively referred to herein as "Patent Rights";
- C. Pursuant to Section 4 of the Settlement Agreement, Assignee has consented in writing to pay all costs associated with the Patent Rights incurred after November 18, 2004; and
- D. Assignee desires to acquire, and Assignor desires to assign, the Patent Rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, of the mutual promises set forth below and of other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties, intending to be legally bound, agree as follows:

ASSIGNMENT


1. Assignment. Assignor hereby sells, assigns and transfers to Assignee all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Patent Rights throughout the world, the same to be held and enjoyed by Assignee for its own use and enjoyment, and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns and legal representatives, to the end of the terms for which any patents resulting from the Patent Rights will be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor if this assignment had not been made, including the right of Assignor to pursue all potential claims for damages by

reason of past infringement of the Patent Rights, with the right to sue for, and collect the same for Assignee's own use and benefit, and for the use and benefit of Assignee's successors, assigns and other legal representatives.

2. Disclaimer. Assignee acknowledges and agrees that Assignor has not made nor will make any warranty whatsoever, whether express, implied or statutory, with respect to the Inventions' merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose or of any product or method incorporating or made by use of the Inventions, and Assignor makes no warranty that anything made, used, sold or otherwise disposed of under the Patent Rights is or will be free from infringement of any patent or any other intangible right of any third party.
