And the Inventor authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents to issue the said Letters Patent to the Assignee.

And for the consideration aforesaid, the Inventor agrees that the Inventor will, upon request,

communicate to the Assignee or the representatives thereof any facts known to the Inventor respecting the invention or improvements of the Application, and will, upon request, but without expense to the Inventor, testify in any legal proceedings, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuation, reissue, re-examination, renewal and extension applications, and generally do all other and further lawful acts deemed necessary or expedient by the Assignee or by counsel for the Assignee to assist or enable the Assignee to obtain and enforce full benefits from the rights and interests herein assigned.

This assignment shall be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the Inventor, and shall inure to the benefit of administrators, successors and assigns, as the case may be, of the Assignee.
