

License: This document also confirms the paid-up license reserved to the U.S. Government in the preceding paragraph. It is understood and agreed that this document does not preclude the Government from asserting rights under the provisions of said Contract, or any other agreement between the Government and the Contractor, or any other rights of the Government with respect to the subject invention.

The Contract also grants the Government an irrevocable power to inspect and make copies of any other patent applications, domestic or foreign, that may be filed on the subject invention.
