

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, 1) **Emmanuelle Lauber**, a citizen of France, residing at Les Ormes 2, Bat. D2, Apt. 11, Rue Salvador Allende, 31320 Castanet-Tolosan France; 2) **Hubert Guilley**, a citizen of France, residing at 32, rue de l'Herbe, F-67370 Berstett, France; 3) **Ken Richards**, a citizen of France, residing at 2, rue Principale, F-67370 Pfulgriesheim, France; 4) **Gerard Jonard**, a citizen of France, residing at 9, quai de Chanoine Winterer, F-67000 Strasbourg, France; hereinafter referred to as Assignor (collectively if more than one inventor is listed above), have invented certain new and useful improvements in P15 HAIRPIN CONSTRUCTS AND USE, the specification of which was filed on May 3, 2006 as Application No. 11/418,384.

AND ASSIGNOR HEREBY covenants and agrees that it will communicate to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to it respecting said improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said improvements in the United States of America.
