ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, THOMAS W. ZELINSKI, a citizen of the United States residing at 735 London Street, Menasha, Wisconsin 54952 ("Assignor"), have invented certain new and useful improvements in "PRESSWARE DIE SET WITH PNEUMATIC BLANK FEED," for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States was filed on June 12, 2006, and accorded Serial No. 11/451,057 ("Application"); and

AND ASSIGNOR HEREBY authorizes and requests the Commissioner for Patents or any other proper officer or agency of any country whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as described above, to issue all said Letters Patent to FJC, as assignee;

AND ASSIGNOR HEREBY warrants and covenants that I have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned and that I have not executed and will not execute any instrument or assignment in conflict with this Assignment;

AND ASSIGNOR HEREBY agrees to communicate to FJC or its representatives any facts known to us respecting said invention and/or Application, to execute all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reexamination, reissue and foreign applications, sign all lawful documents and make all rightful oaths and declarations relating to said invention and/or Application, and to testify in any judicial or administrative proceeding and generally do everything possible to aid FJC to secure full and complete protection for the invention and/or Application or that may be necessary to vest in FJC the complete title to the invention and/or Application hereby conveyed and to enable it to record said title and enforce said Letters Patent in the United States or any foreign country when requested so to do by FJC.
