


WHEREAS, Larry L. Klein, Peggy P. Huang, John T. Randolph, Douglas K. Hutchinson, Ming C. Yeung and Charles A. Flentge hereinafter called the "Assignors", have made the invention described in the United States patent application entitled ANTI-INFECTIVE AGENTS that has a U.S. Patent Application Serial Number of 11/363,377 and was filed on February 27, 2006;

The Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks is hereby authorized and requested to issue patents to the Assignee in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.




