ASSIGNMENT

Invention to The Research Foundation of the State of New York, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

AND I HEREBY covenant that I have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that I have not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith.

AND I HEREBY further covenant and agree that I will communicate to The Research Foundation of the State of New York, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns, any facts known to me respecting the Invention and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all applications claiming priority, extension, divisional, continuation, renewal, and reissue applications, make all rightful declarations and/or oaths and generally do everything possible to aid The Research Foundation of the State of New York, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for the Invention in all countries.
