## PATENT ASSIGNMENT

1. James McCook (herein after "Assignor"), having an address at 11543 101<sup>st</sup> Street, Largo, FL 33773, for good and valuable consideration and for the consideration as stated in the Asset Purchase Agreement of even date herewith by and between the Assignor and the Assignee, and other good and sufficient considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, by theses presents have sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by theses presents sell, assign, transfer and set over unto Flash Pump LLC, a limited liability company of the State of new York, located and doing business at 2680 Belcher Street, Baldwin, New York 11510, as assignee, and its successors, assigns and legal representatives (the "Assignee"), effective as of the date hereof, its entire right, title and interest, for all countries (a) in the patent and the invention described and claimed in U. S. Patent No. 6,447,261 B1 and all reissues and extensions thereof; and all applications for industrial property protection, together with the right to file such application and the right to claim for the same the priority rights derived from said United States application under the Patent Laws of the United States, the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, or any other international agreement or the domestic laws of the country in which any such application is filed, as may be applicable; and all applications for industrial property protection, including, without limitation, all applications for patents, utility models, and designs which may hereafter be filed for said invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States, together with the right to file such applications; and all forms of industrial property protection, including, without limitation, patents, utility models, inventors' certificates and designs which may be granted for said invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States and all extensions, renewal and reissues thereof.

2. The Assignor hereby authorizes and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States and any Official of any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty is to issue patents or other evidence or forms of industrial property on applications as aforesaid Assignor to issue the same to the Assignee, its successor, assigns and legal representatives, or to such nominees as it may designate.

3. The Assignor agrees that, when requested, he will, without charge to the Assignee, sign all papers, take all rightful oaths, and do all acts which may be necessary, desirable or convenient for securing and maintaining patents for the inventions in any and all countries and for vesting title thereto in the Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives or nominees.



The Assignor hereby consents that a copy of this assignment shall be deemed a full legal and formal equivalent of any assignment, consent to file or like document which may be required in any country for any purpose and more particularly in proof of the right of the assignee or nominee to claim the aforesaid benefit of the right of priority provided by the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, or by any convention which may henceforth be substituted for it.

6. The Assignor covenants with the Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives or nominees that the rights and property herein conveyed are free and clear of any encumbrances, and that the Assignor has full right to convey the same as herein expressed.
