ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, We, **Patricia Piers**, a citizen of Canada, residing at Steenhouwerskade 44, NL-9718DD, Groningen, The Netherlands, and **Henk Weeber**, a citizen of The Netherlands, residing at Veenweg 18C, 9728 NL, Groningen, The Netherlands (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNORS"), have invented certain new and useful improvements in a **Ophthalmic Lenses Capable of Reducing Chromatic Aberration**, for which we have executed an application for Letters Patent in the United States as U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 11/099,342 filed April 5, 2005; and

AND WHEREAS, **Advanced Medical Optics, Inc.**, a Delaware Corporation, with its principal place of business at 1700 E. St. Andrew Place, Santa Ana, CA 92705, (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNEE"), desires to acquire the entire right, title, and interest in and to the said improvements and the said Application.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we, said ASSIGNORS, hereby sell, assign, and transfer and set over, unto said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, the entire right, title and interest in, to and under said invention, and said United States application and all divisions, renewals, and continuations thereof, and all Patents of the United States which may be granted thereon and all reissues, reexaminations and extensions thereof; and all applications for industrial property protection, including, without limitation, all applications for patents, utility models, and designs which may hereafter be filed for said invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States, together with the right to file such applications and the right to claim for the same the priority rights derived from said United States application under the Patent Laws of the United States, the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, or any other international agreement or the domestic laws of the country in which any such application is filed, as may be applicable; and all forms of industrial and/or intellectual property protection, including, without limitation, patents, utility models and designs which may be granted for said invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States and all extensions, renewals, reexaminations and reissues thereof.




