Assignor also hereby grants, assigns and conveys to Assignee the right to apply anywhere in the world for foreign patent(s) or the equivalent in respect of or based upon the Patents and/or any Related U.S. or Foreign Patent Filings, including, but not limited to, the right to claim the benefit of any international convention or treaty including the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) and to claim priority pursuant to rights accorded Assignor under the terms of the International (Paris) Convention For The Protection of Industrial Property and any and all other available international conventions and treaties. Assignor also sells, assigns and transfers to Assignee the right to assert and enforce all rights arising from the Patents and any Related U.S. or Foreign Patent Filings with respect to any infringement of same that occurred before execution of this Assignment and to retain any monies or other damages or awards that may be received by Assignee as a result thereof.
