

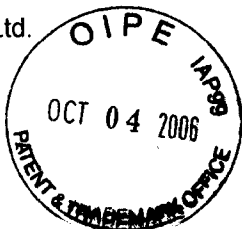



AND said ASSIGNOR hereby covenants and warrants that it has not and will not execute any other agreement in conflict herewith.


