ASSIGNMENT

Whereas, FREDDIE G. SCHIMANSKI, who resides at 56 Bridle Path Lane, Madison, CT 06443, and ALAN J. MICHAUD, who resides at 4 Templeton Road, Wallingford, CT 06492, (collectively referred to hereinafter as "Assignors") have made certain inventions and discoveries set forth in an international patent application entitled "VOLUMETRIC SEALING SYSTEM", which application was filed in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on May 11, 2006 under international application number PCT/US2006/18330.

1. Assign, transfer and convey to Assignee the entire right, title and interest in and to said inventions and discoveries, said international patent application, any related applications for Letters Patent of the United States of America, any and all other applications for Letters Patent on said inventions and discoveries in whatsoever countries, including all divisional, renewal, substitute, continuation and Convention applications based in whole or in part upon said inventions or discoveries, or upon said applications, and any and all Letters Patent and reissues and extensions of Letters Patent granted for said inventions and discoveries or upon said applications, and every priority right that is or may be predicated upon or arise from said inventions, said discoveries, said applications and said Letters Patent;
2. Authorize Assignee to file patent applications in any or all countries on any or all of said inventions and discoveries in name of Assignee or otherwise as Assignee may deem advisable, under the International Convention or otherwise;
3. Authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents of the United States of America and the empowered officials of all other governments to issue or transfer all said Letters Patent to Assignee, as assignee of the entire right, title and interest therein or otherwise as Assignee may direct;
4. Warrant that Assignors have not knowingly conveyed to others any right in said inventions, discoveries, applications or patents or any license to use the same or to make, use or sell anything embodying or utilizing any of said inventions or discoveries; and that Assignors have good right to assign the same to Assignee without encumbrance;
5. Bind Assignors and its heirs, legal representatives and assigns, to do, upon

Assignee's request and at its expense, but without additional consideration to Assignors or its heirs, legal representatives or assigns, all acts reasonably serving to assure that said inventions and discoveries, said patent applications and said Letters Patent shall be held and enjoyed by Assignee as fully and entirely as the same could have been held and enjoyed by Assignors, its heirs, legal representatives and assigns, if this assignment had not been made; and particularly to execute and deliver to Assignee all lawful application documents including petitions, specifications, and oaths, and all assignments, disclaimers, and lawful affidavits in form and substance as may be requested by Assignee; to communicate to Assignee all facts known to Assignors relating to said inventions and discoveries or the history thereof; and to furnish Assignee with any and all documents, photographs, models, samples and other physical exhibits in Assignors' control or in the control of Assignors' heirs, legal representatives or assigns and which may be useful for establishing the facts of the conceptions, disclosures, and reduction to practice of said inventions and discoveries.

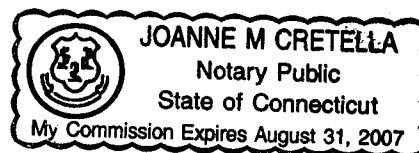
