Nelson and Marion L. Mast do hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents to issue any and all United States Letters Patent for the aforesaid inventions and improvements to said Dayton Rogers Manufacturing Co., its successors and assigns.

AND, for the consideration aforesaid, Eric W. Nelson and Marion L. Mast do hereby agree that their executors and legal representatives will make, execute and deliver any and all other instruments in writing including any other documents, and will

communicate to said Dayton Rogers Manufacturing Co., its successors and representatives all facts known to them relating to said improvements and the history thereof and will testify in all legal proceedings and generally do all things which may be necessary or desirable to more effectually secure to and vest in Dayton Rogers Manufacturing Co., its successors or assigns the entire right, title and interest in and to said improvements, inventions, applications, Letters Patent, rights, titles, benefits, privileges and advantages hereby sold, assigned and conveyed, or intended so to be.

AND, furthermore, Eric W. Nelson and Marion L. Mast, covenant and agree with said Dayton Rogers Manufacturing Co., its successors and assigns, that no assignment, grant, mortgage, license or other agreement affecting the rights and property herein conveyed has been made to others by Eric W. Nelson and Marion L. Mast and that full right to convey the same as herein expressed is possessed by Eric W. Nelson and Marion L. Mast.

The parties hereto acknowledge that they have specifically requested the present agreement to be drawn up in the English language.

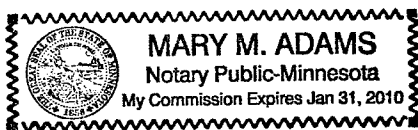

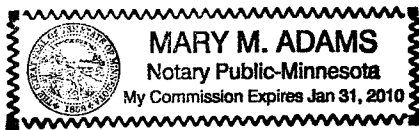
