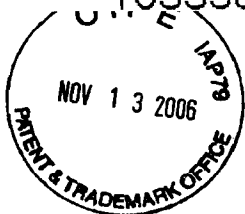

ASSIGNMENT

Whereas We, Walter J. Feller, whose residence address is 20 Jensen Heights, Airdrie, Alberta, CANADA, T4B 1P7, Patrick C. 
