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TERMINATION AND RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST
(Patents)

This RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST (Patents) (this "Release") is made and effective as the date indicated below and is granted by **CREDIT SUISSE**, a Swiss Bank, in its capacity as administrative agent and collateral agent (the "Collateral Agent"), in favor of AFMEDICA, INC., a Delaware corporation ("Releasee").

WHEREAS, the Releasee and the Collateral Agent are parties to that certain Credit Agreement dated as of March 23, 2006 (the "Credit Agreement");

WHEREAS, the Releasee and the Collateral Agent are parties to that certain U.S. Security Agreement dated as of March 23, 2006 (as amended, modified, restated and/or supplemented from time to time, the "Security Agreement");

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Credit Agreement and the Security Agreement, the Releasee executed that certain Patent Security Agreement dated as of March 23, 2006 and the Amended and Restated Patent Security Agreement dated as of August 18, 2006 (together, the "Patent Security Agreements") in favor of the Collateral Agent, pursuant to which the Releasee granted to the Collateral Agent a continuing security interest in, to and under all of Releasee's right, title and interest in, to and under the Patents and patent applications set forth on Schedule A attached hereto, and all Receivables and Proceeds thereof, (collectively, the "Patent Collateral");

WHEREAS, the Patent Security Agreement was recorded at the United States Patent and Trademark Office at Reel 017448/Frame 0676;

WHEREAS, the Collateral Agent acknowledges that Releasee has fully performed and satisfied all obligations, and has paid in full all of its outstanding indebtedness, secured by the Patent Collateral conveyed pursuant to and in connection with the Credit Agreement, Security Agreement and the Patent Security Agreements;

WHEREAS, the Releasee requests that the Collateral Agent terminate, release and discharge fully its security interest in and to the Patent Collateral; and

WHEREAS, the Collateral Agent wishes to terminate, release and discharge fully such security interest.

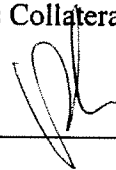

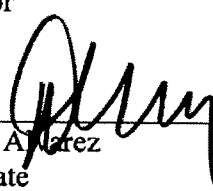

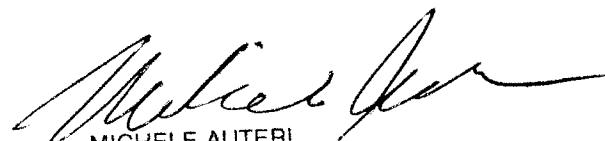
