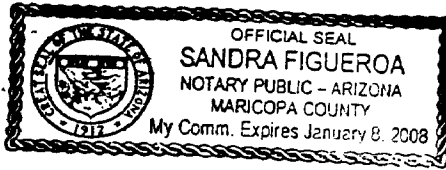

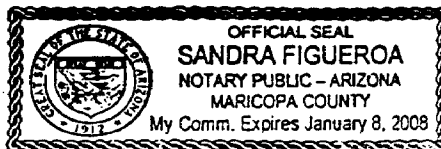

This application and papers have been reviewed and found in compliance with 37 C.F.R. §1.47(a).


