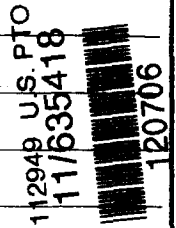


accordance with this assignment.






