NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, the forgiveness of loans in the amount of Twenty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty (\$29,750.00) Dollars and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which hereby is acknowledged, the said ASSIGNOR has sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, an undivided One Hundred (100%) percent share in the right, title and interest in and to said PROPERTIES, and all divisions, renewals and continuations thereof, and all Letters Patent of the United States which may be granted thereon and all reissues and extensions thereof, to the full end of the term thereof, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by ASSIGNOR had this assignment and sale not been made, including all rights to recover damages for any and all past infringement, and all applications for Letters Patent which may hereafter be filed for said PROPERTIES in any country or countries foreign to the United States, and all Letters Patent which may be granted for said PROPERTIES in any country or countries foreign to the United States and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof and all rights of priority in any such country or countries based upon the filing of applications for said PROPERTIES for Letters Patent of the United States which are created by any law, treaty or international convention.



and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said PROPERTIES in all countries.


