

We authorize and request the attorneys of record in said application to insert in this assignment the date and serial number of said application when officially known.



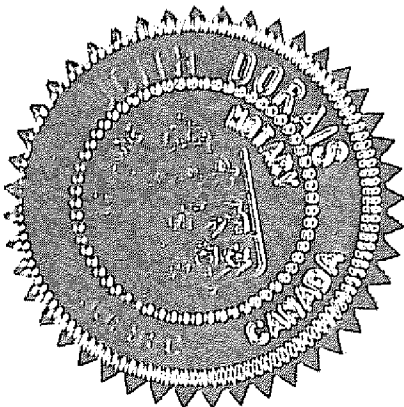
